Look what the Lord has done. The story of Baja Vision was born when I was 16 years old. I went to a couple of Bible colleges- Biblical colleges in Eagle Pass, Texas and the Dallas Christian College. 55 five years later I earned my doctorate in Divinity from Northwest Christian College in Eugene, Oregon. More than 55 years of nonstop service for the Lord! In these years the Lord has allowed me to build a ministry called Baja Vision Ministries whose purpose is to build homes for the poor. We do this with the help of many church groups from America, Russia, Australia, Germany and Mexico to bless the poor.

We have also built 10 elderly homes in which 200 elderly people currently live. With the help of a group from Australia, we have built 6 church buildings for pastors in Tijuana, Tecate and Ensenada. We also have built a hospice that now has 26 sick people. We feed them, we clothe them, and we are always looking for medical supplies for them. We currently have a person that needs colostomy bags. We also have built a hospital for the terminal ill that has close to 30 sick people. All of this sounds like a lot of work, but we thank each one of the many groups that come to lift our arms so we can rest.

We are working with emigrants that come from South America, our church in Arcadia, California. Dr. John Gatuso brought a group of people who built 10 small homes so that they can have privacy. We were blessed by our friends in Nebraska who have brought food for the elderly home, for City of Angels, for the homes and for the terminally ill. One of my jobs is constantly trying to secure medical supplies that are graciously donated by John Crowder and his connections to help with the need of people in need. The latest project that I have is a rehab center run by a former chief police. I have worked in different community projects, I preach there the last Sunday of every month and I am his pastor. Right now they are in need of a building to have church services. The joy that these guys have when they sing to the Lord is a blessing to me. The love that police chief Paz reflects on this ministry is amazing. I am very happy to be a part of this, and we pray we can find the funds of one thousand dollars monthly to divide amongst these ministries.

We ask for your prayers for health issues that have plagued our home. However, nothing will stop us. We will continue taking precautions, but The Lord is bigger than COVID 19, and we will work carefully and we thank God for His Grace.
